

AGREEMENT

on the cooperation between the

International Federation for Medical and Biological Engineering (IFMBE)

and

International Advisory Board (IAB) of the BIOMAG conferences

In support and recognition of the research excellence in the field of biomagnetism and the exchange of the ideas and joint initiatives the IFMBE and the IAB of the BIOMAG conferences agree to continue and extend their collaboration established during Biomag2010 in Dubrovnik, Croatia by:

1. James Zimmerman Prize sponsored by the IFMBE – JZP Charter appended;

2. Organization of a Special Session at every World Congress;

2. 1. Special Session on biomagnetism at the World Congresses on Medical Physics and Biomedical Engineering

The Chair of the International Advisory Board of the BIOMAG conferences is invited to organize or invite applications for the organization of a Special Session on biomagnetism at every World Congress. The proposal for particular topics of the Special Session shall be presented to the IFMBE at least one year before the beginning of the World Congress.

3. Invitation to the organizers of the future BIOMAG conferences to consider publishing the BIOMAG Proceedings within the IFMBE Springer Proceedings Series;

3. 1. Proceedings of BIOMAG Conferences

The IFMBE invites the IAB of the BIOMAG conferences to suggest to the organizers of the BIOMAG conferences to publish the proceedings of the International Conferences on Biomagnetism in the Springer IFMBE Proceedings Series as paper and electronic (CD or DVD and on-line) publications. Electronic publications are free of charge to the organizers of the BIOMAG conferences. The agreement on this publication must be made at least one year before the beginning of the Conference.


4. Any other initiative and joint activity of mutual interest.

This Agreement will be posted on the web pages of the IFMBE and the BIOMAG conferences and the World Congresses.


The logo of the IFMBE will be published on the home page of the BIOMAG conferences under the notice "Supported by IFMBE" and a live link to the IFMBE home page.
